GENERAL RULES:

1. Please see 4-H Division Rules and Special Contest Rules Section for information on Record Books, etc.
2. Horses must have IDs entered in 4honline.com by **May 1**.
3. All rules of the show shall be governed by the current Colorado 4-H Horse Rule Book.
4. All 4-H participants must have passed Level 1 prior to exhibiting at fair. If only showing at halter, they must have passed the halter section. Working Ranch Horse, Roping and Hunter Hack participants must have passed Level 2. Regardless of division entered, all 4-H Horse members showing at County Fair **must participate in no less than 2 approved practices.**
5. Horse Novice classes are for horse members to walk trot only, regardless of age. Winners in this class receive a rosette only and DO NOT receive a showmanship award. First year members have the option of competing in their appropriate age division rather than the novice class but they may not compete in both.
6. If there are 12 or more contestants in a class, the class may be split. The top five places from each group will be entered into a final for top placings.
7. Any horse that is uncontrollable while on the fairgrounds will be dismissed.
8. If a participant's equipment breaks, there will be no re-ride granted.
9. No animals under the age of three shall be exhibited. Junior Horses are those 3-5 years of age. Senior Horses are those 6 years and older, age of horse as of January 1 of the current year. No stallions will be shown.
10. Only the 4-H member will be allowed to ride their horse while on the fairgrounds.
11. Horse must be properly and completely tacked before riding.
4-H member will be dressed in appropriate attire while horseback.
Tack and Attire:
Personal Attire: English Dress Code will be enforced in English Performance Classes and Western Dress Code will be enforced in all Western Performance Classes, Showmanship, Halter, Gymkhana, Working Ranch Horse and Roping according to the current 4-H Colorado Horseshow Rule Book.
Tack: English Equipment rules will be enforced in English Performance Classes and Western Equipment rules will be in enforced in all Western Performance Classes, Showmanship, Halter, Gymkhana, Working Ranch Horse and Roping according to the current 4-H Colorado Horseshow Rule book.
12. 4-H members should perform all caretaking, grooming, and other related activities regarding their horse and stall that can be done safely.
13. Any abuse of livestock or horses will result in automatic expulsion from the event.
14. Class orders will be posted. Classes may not run in the order printed in the fairbook.
15. Grand Champion awards will be given to the 4-Hers with the highest total points/scores accumulated with one horse-one rider basis.
16. Grand Champion awards will be given per age division in Performance, Ranch Horse and Gymkhana classes.

4-H HORSE PERFORMANCE

Additional Rules:

1. No Chaps allowed in the horsemanship class.
2. Guidelines and rules for the horse performance classes will be taken from the current Colorado 4-H Horse Show Rule Book.
3. Trail Class will be run simultaneously with other classes. Trail can be ridden in either Western or English Tack and attire.
4. Grand Champion Performance Awards are calculated on a one horse-one rider basis from both Western and English classes: Hunt Seat Equitation, Hunter Under Saddle, Western Pleasure, Western Horsemanship, and Trail. If a rider only rides one discipline and still has the highest total points, they are still eligible for grand champion awards. Neither Showmanship, nor Halter placings will count towards Grand and Reserve Champion Performance awards. However, if a tie exists, showmanship will be used as a tie breaker, followed by coin toss.

1. See 4-H Division Rules and Special Contest Rules Section for more information.
2. Participants in 4-H Gymkhana Events must be enrolled in the Horse Project.
3. Grand Champion Gymkhana awards will be given to the 4-Hers with the highest total points accumulated on a one horse – one rider basis in the gymkhana classes. Awards will be given in the Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Divisions. Tie-breaker will be fastest overall total time, followed by a coin toss.
4. State 4-H rules require any participant in the gymkhana to wear an approved helmet in addition to tack and attire requirements.

4-H WORKING RANCH HORSE/ROPING

Additional Rules:

1. 4-H Working Ranch Horse and Cattle Events are open to 4-Hers enrolled in the Activity Group.
2. Classes are divided: Junior (8-13), and Senior (14-18) divisions.
3. All 4-H participants in non-cattle classes must have passed Level 1 Ranch Horse test prior to exhibiting at fair. Members may be required to pass additional safety tests and attend no less than 2 approved practices.
4. Any abuse of livestock or horses will result in automatic expulsion from the event.
5. The Working Ranch Horse Divisions will be conducted according to the rules published in the current State 4-H Horse Show Rule Book.
6. Tack and Attire: Western Dress Code and equipment, according to the current 4-H Colorado Horse Rule Book. If a rider's equipment breaks, there will be no re-ride granted in any class. Any horse with open sores or bleeding apparently caused by tack, equipment, or rough handling shall be eliminated from competition and shall not be placed.
7. Working Ranch Horse classes are based upon a score system. Scoring, penalty points, and rules for all classes are followed according to the Colorado 4-H Horse Show Rule Book.
8. Grand Champion Working Ranch Horse awards will be given to the 4-Hers with the highest total points accumulated on a one horse – one rider basis in the Ranch Horse classes. Awards will be given in the Junior and Senior Divisions. Ties will be broken by highest placing in Ranch Riding, followed by a coin toss.
9. Roping class entries will be determined by the Roping Superintendent. Ground roping is for 4-H members not yet ready to be horseback and rope. See the Colorado 4-H Horse Show Rule Book for specific rules for Team Roping, Breakaway and Steer Stopping.
10. Roping is a county only activity. Participants must have attended no less than 2 practices and have approval of Roping leaders for class selection.
