Additional Rules:

For 2020, Initial heats of swine showmanship will be judged during the market show. The Showmanship judge will be notified of showmanship entries by colored back tags. Exhibitors that the Showmanship Judge wishes to bring back for the final heat will be announced after each market flight and posted in the barns. Final flights will be broken out by age of exhibitors.

#### 4-H MARKET SWINE

Additional Rules:

1. Any market hog that weighs less than 230 lbs. is automatically entered as a prospect.
2. There is an upper weight limit of 285 lbs. Hogs weighing less than 230 lbs. or more than 285 lbs. WILL NOT SELL at the Junior Market Sale nor will they be in the Grand Champion Round.
3. Animals shown in market classes may not be shown in a breeding class.
4. Market swine will be weighed during check-in. They will be weighed as they are unloaded. Market swine must be clean and free of lice and/or worms at check-in. Those exhibitors with unclean swine or swine that exhibit signs of lice and/or worms will be required to remedy the situation or face disqualification from the Fair.
5. Classes of market swine and prospect swine will be divided by weight with no breed divisions. The weight divisions will be determined and posted in the barn area after weigh –in.

**4-H BREEDING SWINE**  
**Tuesday, July 29**

1. There will be no breed division. There will be selection of Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Breeding Swine.
2. Animals shown in breeding classes may not be shown in a market class.
3. All breeding animals will be shown in the age classification listed below without separation into breeds.
4. No intact male swine shall be exhibited on the fair.
5. This is a trailer show, and breeding swine shall be removed from the Fairgrounds after the breeding show is completed.

**Class 2406**      **Junior gilts**, under 6 months of age (born Feb. 1, 2020 or after)  
**Class 2407**      **Senior gilts**, under 1 year of age but more than 6 months of age (born July 31, 2019 to January 31, 2020)  
**Class 2408**      **Sows**, over 1 year of age (born before July 31, 2019)
